Outside of their doctoral research, Jas Brooks (they/them) is an independent media archeology researcher and designer. Their independent research focuses on historical scent technologies and associated media from the 20th century to the present. Jas conserves and analyzes cinematic scent technologies such as AromaRama and Smell-O-Vision (1960s), investigates oral histories from pioneering dot-com era scent tech companies like DigiScents and TriSenx, and documents scented film exhibitions spanning 1900-59. Their work encompasses archival research, practical conservation techniques, and interactive media design, aiming to bridge historical technologies with contemporary artistic practices. Jas's work has been featured in media publications like Perfumer & Flavorist, Ca Fleure Bon, and the Chicago Reader. They are a recipient of the University of Chicago's Media Arts, Data & Design Fellowship, and their work with scent has been recognized twice as a finalist for the Sadakichi Award for Experimental Work with Scent (Art & Olfaction Awards).
